



Three Monthly Forecast

August – October 2009

General Condition

In August the low pressure trough will lie across northern and northeastern regions. It will move downward to lie across central, lower portion of northeastern and eastern regions of Thailand in September and move further towards upper southern Thailand on the following month. Moreover, southwest monsoon will dominate over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand in August and September. Abundant rainfall and floods are expected in some areas mostly in the central and eastern regions. October is the transition period from rainy season to winter, little rain may be experienced in upper Thailand. High pressure areas from China will extend its ridge to cover northern and northeastern Thailand to come with cool weather and morning fog especially during late October.

Warning: There is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean or the South China Sea move near or pass through northern and northeastern regions and cause increasing in rainfall especially in upper Thailand. Therefore, people should continually follow the weather news.
