Three Monthly Forecast March – may 2009

Issued on 26 February 2009

General Condition

In early March, cool weather will remains in the morning across the upper portions of northern and northeastern parts but contrastly, hot weather will generally be found during day time. After that, heat low pressure cell will cover the upper Thailand until April and contribute to seasonably, hot weather in general and very hot in many areas on some days, mainly in northern, northeastern and central parts. However, the confluence of easterly and southerly winds sometimes lie over upper Thailand, causing thundershowers and decreasing in temperature.

In May, the transition period from summer to rainy season. The rather active southwest monsoon will prevail over Thailand in the second half of the month, resulting in scattered rain and heavy falls in many areas of upper Thailand. For southern Thailand, scattered thundershowers with isolated heavy falls will occur especially in the west coast.

Generally speaking, mean temperature will be near normal and rainfall is expected be slightly above normal.

Warning:

March and April - The possibility of the occurrences of thunderstorms with gust and hail are high. So people should beware of natural disaster and should follow the weather forecast for further information.

The end of April to May - The low pressure cell in the Andaman Sea that sometimes strengthen to be tropical cyclone may affect Thailand's rainfall especially in northern, central and southern Thailand.
