



## Three Monthly Forecast

November 2010 – January 2011

Issued 27 October 2010

### Meteorological Department

#### General Condition

**Upper Thailand.** High pressure areas from China will occasionally extend its ridge to cover upper Thailand. Abundant slightly rainfall remain in upper Thailand with cool and cold weather especially in December and January. Cold to very cold with dense fog and frost are expected over mountainous areas and mountain tops especially in northern and northeastern Thailand.

**Southern part.** Low monsoon trough will lie across the lower southern Thailand and northeast monsoon will prevail over the Gulf of Thailand and southern part, It will bringing further heavy rainfall. However, rainfall amounts are likely below average in several areas.

**Warning :** - In November and December, there is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean or the South China Sea move through southern parts of Thailand. Abundant rainfall with storm surge over the coastal areas of southern Thailand, people and navigators should follow the weather forecast for further information.

- In December, Westerly trough may move from Myanmar through upper Thailand, causing thundershowers and gust in some areas. The active low pressure cell in the lower Gulf of Thailand or the lower South China Sea may be active to the tropical cyclones and move through southern Thailand, causing abundant rainfall in those areas with storm surge over the coastal areas of southern Thailand, people and navigators should follow the weather forecast for further information.
