Three Monthly Forecast June – August 2011 Issued on 25 May 2011

General Condition

In the early June, the southwest monsoon will prevail over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand, It will be rather strong in some periods. Accompanying, the low pressure trough will lie across Northern and the upper of northeastern parts. Resulting in rainfall and will have heavy rain on some days, but not continuous. Then, around the second half of June to the first half of July, the low pressure trough will lie across southern China and southwest monsoon which prevailed over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand will weaken. Rainfall amount will decreasing over Thailand. Since the second half of July to August, the low pressure trough will move back to lie across the upper Thailand and the southwest monsoon prominently prevail over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand, resulting in increasing in rainfall.

Generally speaking, the amount of rainfall in Thailand will be slightly below normal, and the average temperature will be slightly above normal.

Warning :

June and July – The tropical cyclone generating in the Western North Pacific Ocean or South China Sea may induce the strength of southwest monsoon and cause increasing in rainfall especially in eastern and southern Thailand.

August - There is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean move near or pass through northeastern or northern Thailand. Therefore, people should continually follow the weather news.
