## Three Monthly Forecast August – October 2011 Issued on 26 July 2011

### General Condition

In August and September. The low pressure trough will lie across the upper Thailand and southwest monsoon which prevailed over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand will be strength. Abundant rainfall amount will increasing over Thailand and floods are expected in some areas. October is the transition period from rainy season to winter, little rain may be experienced in upper Thailand. High pressure areas from China will extend its ridge to cover northern and northeastern Thailand to come with cool weather and morning fog especially during late October. Northeast monsoon will prevailed over the Gulf of Thailand and southern part, bringing further heavy rain to southern Thailand.

Generally speaking, the amount of rainfall in Thailand will be slightly above normal, and the average temperature will be near normal.

### **++ Warning ++**

**There is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean or the South China Sea move near or pass through upper Thailand in August – September and pass through eastern part and upper southern Thailand in October. Therefore, people should continually follow the weather news.**
